The Bellingham Herald is sponsoring one \$1,000 scholarship for a Western Washington University student who has a record of service to diversity issues, working with underrepresented populations and communities, and been enrolled at Western for one (1) year.

Criteria

- Students who demonstrate a strong commitment to diversity issues in campus or community activities;
- Students who will be in full-time status (12 or more credits) during the 2009-2010 academic year;
- Students must be currently enrolled at Western and have attended for a minimum of one full year;
- Students do not need to be a minority;
- Students must be making satisfactory academic progress (2.0 GPA.)

Considerations

Selection will be based on student's record of service to campus underrepresented groups prior to and while at Western; academic achievements and community service activities; and a strong commitment to leadership within underrepresented community projects.

Application

- Completed Scholarship Application form (available in the ESC, Viking Union 420, or online: <http://esc.as.wvu.edu/>.)
- Copy of WWU transcript (unofficial transcript acceptable.)
- Three (3) letters of recommendation required, due by April 24 2009.
